- Understand the physical levels of your tour's daily activities and be capable of fully and happily (no one likes a grumpy or complaining traveller) participating without any assistance in the following levels of activity:
- Walk 10,000+ steps over the course of the day, up and down stairs, and over unpaved or cobblestone surfaces
