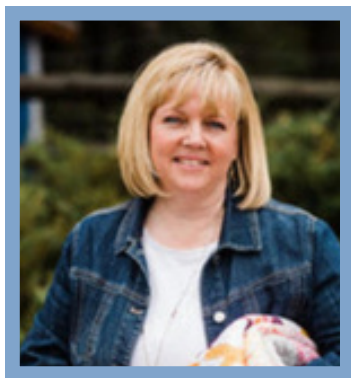
Whether you're an experienced traveller or embarking on your very first international adventure, you won't be travelling alone. By the end of the journey, strangers have become friends.
